

## **Borough Council Elections**

Borough Council Elections have been held. There has been no change in control and no change in Councillors. There will be a General Election held next year and wards in this area will be changed.

#### **Pothole Scheme**

A new pothole repair scheme is being rolled out. The details of the scheme are not yet confirmed. There is also a footpath repair scheme. The Parish Council can compile a list of footpaths and potholes that need attention, including photographs of the defects that can be forwarded to Cllr. Buckley.

## **Budget**

There is currently a shortfall in the budget of £30 million. Savings will have to be made next year which may affect social care. Fees for waste management will also be looked at. The cost of disposal of non-recyclable waste is £100 to £140 per ton which is far higher than recyclable waste. The charge for collection of green waste should be rolled out in June. Half price compost bins are available to purchase on the LoveEssex.com website for households that wish to compost their green waste.
