

Demolish ancillary stable structures to rear and convert existing annex/stables/garage building into an independent 4 bed dwelling – **The Ranch, Church Lane, Ramsden Crays, Billericay**

Application No. 23/00630/VAR

Variation of Condition 2 (approved plans) and Condition 3 (materials) of planning permission 17/00717/FULL, replacing approved plans with proposed amended plans incorporating raised roof ridgeline, insertion of obscure glazed windows to first floor flank elevations, link to converted and altered detached garage for use as a utility room and use of render with contrasting brick/stone to exterior walls and black slate/tiles to roof – **Gardone, Oak Avenue, Crays Hill, Billericay**
