

Projects:

During the last few years the Parish Council has purchased new Waste Bins and Dog Poo Bins and is currently in the process of buying a memorial bench dedicated to Elizabeth 2^{nd.} which hopefully will be part funded by a grant from Essex County Council. In addition we hope to replace the broken bench in London Road.

Memorial Sunday

The Annual Remembrance Service in November was a memorable morning and very well attended by a number of residents and visitors, including Borough and County Councillors and the Police.

The Service was given by the preacher from Great Burstead and South Green and was followed by light refreshments at the Shepherd and Dog Public House.

Planning:

Local Council Tax:

I am pleased to announce that for the second year running we managed to avoid any increase in the Parish Precept and now have a reasonable Reserve to carry forward... As a result there will be no increase again for the year commencing 1st April2024
