16/01 GARDINERS LANE

To discuss the development of the pinch point in Gardiners Lane. Cllr. McPherson-Davis commented that further to recent communication from

E.C.C. it was being considered and is dependent upon budget restrictions.

17/01 SAFETY BARRIER - HARDINGS ELMS ROAD

The situation with the progress for a safety barrier at Hardings Elms Road, further to response received from E.C.C.

E.C.C. has replied requesting a site visit with a councillor and either Cllr. Peake or Cllr. Lucas will be available.

18/01 BUS SHELTER

Update by Councillor Lucas of the situation regarding the request for a fourth grant. No update todate.

Pending installation of third bus shelter agreement requested from the Parish Council to give permission for the Clerk to then arrange for a cheque to be sent to Littlethorpe of Leicester for £6,227.50 inclusive of VAT and payment for insurance.

It was agreed as there is no August meeting scheduled that the Clerk can arrange the payment of the insurance and then to issue a cheque on receipt of an invoice for the full amount when the bus shelter has been installed.

20/01 NEW BUS STOPS IN ESSEX - E.C.C.
