75/14 PLANNING APPLICATIONS:

Application 14/00263/LDC. Establish the lawfulness of a proposed first floor rear extension.

Location: Highlands, London Road, Crays Hill, Billericay, Essex. No comment.

Application 14/00280/FULL. Conversion of garage into a bedroom, provision of window with obscured glazing at first floor level to serve en suite.
Location: 25 Church Road, Crays Hill, Billericay, Essex.
Not in Parish of Ramsden Crays.

Application 14/00324/FULL. Demolition of existing worship hall and erection of two-storey pitched roof building comprising a cosmetic centre at ground floor level and two-bedroom residential flat at first floor with association car parking.
Location: All Saints Church and Community Centre, Crays Hill, Billericay, Essex.

The Parish Council objected on the grounds of: Building out of character and balcony intrusive to residents. Air condition units will generate noise to other residents. Location of the bin store will obstruct the sight line for vehicles accessing Oak Avenue and those exiting the car park.

Parking bays 13 and 4 when occupied will obstruct the sight lines.

The ground floor frontage of the new building extends too far North and would reduce the sight lines.

Too much congestion at the car park, no turning space for vehicles.

Oak Avenue is a private road so external parking is not available.
