### Projects:

The Parish Council is reviewing the precept – budget for Ramsden Crays for the year 2012/2013.

It would like to increase the precept by 30% which should equate to little more than £19.19 per annum or 37 pence per month on 2011/12 Band D – currently at £14.76 per annum. The Parish Council appreciates the economic situation, however it is keen to improve the Parish facilities and area for the residents and to assist with this will require additional fundings to be able to apply for match funding.

Future projects that we would like to develop within the Parish of Ramsden Crays are:

- (i) Funding for the fixed War Memorial in memory of those who have lost their lives in the course of their duties in World War I and II. A resident has kindly offered the donation of land for this memorial.
- (ii) Planting additional bulbs and plants within the area.
- (iii) Long term project to Improvement the park/recreational facilities for children and families and the "retired" generation of Ramsden Crays.

For these projects to have the opportunity to develop further unlike future year's when the Parish Council has either kept the precept the same, or there has been a slight increase, it would be necessary to increase it in a higher proportion. The Parish Council would very much appreciate your comments either on this suggestion and/or the types of projects that you as the resident would like to see within the area.
