This newsletter includes information about the activities of the Parish Council over the last year and Parish Council contact points.

Dates for forthcoming Meetings:

Parish Council Meetings are generally held on the third Wednesday of each month (although please check the notice board or enquire of the Parish Clerk if you are unsure, at 7.00 p.m. (except August)

Dates scheduled for 2015 are: 21st January, 11th February, 18th March, 15th April – 6.30 p.m. Annual Parish Meeting, 7.00 p.m. Parish Council Meeting, 20th May – Annual Meeting of Ramsden Crays Parish Council,

The Public are very welcome to attend the Parish Council meetings although currently the location for the meetings has yet to be confirmed as the Council is in dispute with the school as it is refusing to allow us to hold the meetings at this venue. New Projects:

Outside Gym

The outside new gym equipment within the Parish has now been installed and is available for visitors and residents to use. The cost of this purchase was £9,995.00 and funding towards this was received from Essex County Council of £5,000.00 and the remainder from Ramsden Crays Parish Council.

The zip wire equipment was installed earlier in the year as published in the newspaper.







War Memorial

The War Memorial Wall has now been completed at a cost of £10,320.00 inclusive of VAT. Funding of £7,400.00 was received from Veolia North Thames Trust and the remainder from Ramsden Crays Parish Council.

The War Memorial was purchased at a cost of £5,760.00 inclusive of VAT. £4,800.00 was received as funding from Basildon Borough Council an official ceremony for the War Memorial should be arranged for early in the New Year.

Village Sign

The Village Sign offered without cost from Basildon Borough Council should be installed early in the New Year to replace the previous sign.
