### Chairman's Report

The Annual Parish Meeting on 24<sup>th</sup> April is minuted in draft format with an update for residents on the notice board and website.

#### Projects in 2017

The Forest of Life project was planted by the Woodland Trust and inspired by Essex Wildlife Trust's vision for 'Living Landscapes' to Restore, Recreate and Reconnect wildlife habitats for the enjoyment of local communities. The wood area contains many different types of native trees including oak, hornbeam and silver birch. Oak trees are like a wildlife hotel that are able to house a large biodiversity of creatures. There are also shrubs including dog rose and hawthorn. These shrubs provide excellent nesting and feeding for a variety of birds. There is also a small natural pond.

Please keep your dog under control in the park. A small part of the pond is for dogs to drink and bath. Dogs must be kept out of the main pond as they could damage the environment for the newts and frogs. This pond is located in the boggy part of the park and includes a viewing mound which incorporates a refuge for cold blooded animals like newts and frogs to hibernate in the winter. As the woodland grows it will become inhabited by birds, insects and small mammals.
